Rules

1. Have fun, be polite, and eat snacks.
2. Register your entry by the entry date using the form below. One form is required per entry.
3. You must present your item in front of the MCAS crowd during your time slot and discuss what it is, what it does, and, if applicable, how you made it.
4. Items must be related to our aquatic hobby. This is a very broad description, so just go with it!
5. You may enter multiple items, but only one item may be presented in each time slot. Everyone should get a chance to present their invention/innovation, so multiple items may not be possible depending on the number of entries. That being said, feel free to enter as many as you like! You will get to show off the item of your choice if multiple presentations are not possible.
6. If at any time something does not seem to be going right, see Rule 1.
7. The Contest Master of Ceremonies (CMoC) has broad powers in order to effectively oversee the contest and may create or remove rules arbitrarily. Tarring and feathering the CMoC is discouraged and may disqualify an otherwise rule-abiding contest participant.
8. All audience members may vote using one form per member and up to three votes per form. Every vote counts equally towards determining the contest winners.
9. Expect lots of cash, a smaller gift certificate, or maybe just an aquarium mermaid decoration as a prize. One prize per participant no matter how many entries or winning votes submitted.
